CULTURAL INSIGHT

If you're not sure about whether to use 唔該 ($m4\ goi1$) or 多謝 ($do1\ ze6$) to say "Thanks", remember that 多謝 ($do1\ ze6$) expresses a deeper appreciation of personal kindness. It is typically used in more formal situations.

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
