CULTURAL INSIGHT

For numbers between 21 and 29, you might hear people using *jaa6* to mean 20 something, instead of *ji6 sap6*. Both can be used in spoken Cantonese.

For example, 21 in Cantonese can be either *jaa6 jat1* or *ji6 sap6 jat1*. Similarly, 27 could be either *jaa6 cat1* or *ji6 sap6 cat1*.
