Mostly they're interchangeable. "邊度" is more formal.

Language Tip

When giving or asking directions, 出邊(ceot1 bin1), "outside", is pronounced as ceot1 bin6 in colloquial Cantonese. Likewise, 入邊(jap6 bin1), "inside", is pronounced as jap6 bin6.
