# SAMPLE SENTENCES

禮拜三使唔使返工啊? lai5 baai3 saam1 sai2 m4 sai2 faan1 gung1 aa6?  Do I (we/you/etc.) need to work on Wednesday?	我要上堂。 ngo5 jiu3 soeng5 tong4. I have to go to school.
聽日放假。 ting1 jat6 fong3 gaa3。	唔使客氣。 m4 sai2 haak3 hei3。
"Tomorrow is a holiday."	You're welcome. (No need to be polite)
禮拜一要返工。 Lai5 baai3 jat1 jiu3 faan1 gung1。	禮拜二去玩。 lai5 baai3 ji6 heoi3 waan2。
On Monday, we have to work.	On Tuesday, we go out.
禮拜六晚去飲酒。 lai5 baai3 luk6 maan5 heoi3 jam2 zau2。	禮拜日休息。 lai5 baai3 jat6 jau1 sik1。
On Saturday night, we drink.	On Sunday, we rest.

## **GRAMMAR**

#### The Focus of This Lesson is To Do or Not To Do

使唔使

"To do or not to do."

This phrase is commonly used when you want to ask or when you're asked, "Do you need to do something?" The subject here isn't specified because it's usually clear in the context. It could be "Do you need to do something?" or "Does he need to do something?"

"Do (you/we/I) need to do (verb)?"

### For Example:

1. 我哋使唔使上堂啊?
ngo5 dei6 sai2 m4 sai2 soeng5 tong4 aa1?
"Do we need to go to class?"

#### **Sample Sentences:**

- 1. 使唔使返工啊? sai2 m4 sai2 faan1 gung1 aa1 ? "Do (we/you/etc.) need to work?"
- 2. 聽日唔使返工。 ting1 jat6 m4 sai2 faan1 gung1。 "(We/You/etc.) don't have to work tomorrow."

#### **Language Tip**

You could replace 使 (*sai2*) with 要 (*jiu3*) in this phrase. So another way of asking, "Do you need to do something?" is 要唔要 plus the verb phrase. To answer the question use 要 when it's "yes" and 唔使 or 唔要 when it's "no."
