

#### **Grammar Points**

The Focus of This Lesson is To Do or Not To Do

使唔使

"To do or not to do."

This phrase is commonly used when you want to ask or when you're asked, "Do you need to do something?" The subject here isn't specified because it's usually clear in the context. It could be "Do you need to do something?" or "Does he need to do something?"

使唔使 + verb phrase + (啊) "Do (you/we/I) need to do (verb)?"

For Example:

1. 我哋使唔使上堂啊?

ngo5 dei6 sai2 m4 sai2 soeng5 tong4 aa1 ?

"Do we need to go to class?"

#### Sample Sentences:

1. 使唔使返工啊?

sai2 m4 sai2 faan1 gung1 aa1 ?

"Do (we/you/etc.) need to work?"

2. 聽日唔使返工。

ting1 jat6 m4 sai2 faan1 gung1 .

"(We/You/etc.) don't have to work tomorrow."

You could replace 使 (sai2) with 要 (jiu3) in this phrase. So another way of asking, "Do you need to do something?" is 要唔要 plus the verb phrase. To answer the question use 要 when it's "yes" and 唔使 or 唔要 when it's "no."
