## English

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### Buddha's Birthday

Hong Kong people really believe in Buddha. No matter whether people do business, drive taxis, or even work for the mob, they all pray to Buddha. People generally set up an altar at home that they'll use to worship their ancestors, elders, and various gods (which ones depend on specifically on your occupation). For example, police have to pay their respects to Kwan Ti, and if you run your own business, you have to pray to the "God of Wealth." I have an altar at home too so I can pay respects to my ancestors. We need to burn one incense stick each day for them before we eat to show our respects.

Of course, we can also see how important Buddhism is to us from the classic Hong Kong movie "Infernal Affairs." In the first scene of the film, Eric Tsang is paying respects to the Buddha and then turns around and says, "The fortune-teller said that my fortune is 'a million perish that one man succeeds.'" How epic is that!

And it's exactly because Cantonese people believe in Buddha that his birthday is so important to us. The Hong Kong government has even made this day a public holiday. Every year on the eighth of April (according to the lunar calendar) everyone will wake up early and go to worship in different temples, burning incense for the Gods.
