# TRADITIONAL CHINESE

2. 導演杜琪峰為呢部片改咗一個富有詩意嘅英文名，A love letter to Hong Kong，就從呢度我哋就大概估到呢部電影嘅畫面會有點樣嘅情調。好多人問，香港電影到底特別喺邊，我個人認為，《文雀》可以回答到呢個問題。電影嘅劇情其實係比較乏善可陳嘅，至少喺我睇嚟，衝突唔夠，而且缺乏令人驚喜嘅峰迴路轉。不過，單從是否完成咗敘事任務嘅角度出發，《文雀》係冇乜嘢可以指責嘅地方。如果係講到鏡頭觀感同埋其它方面，《文雀》可以講得上係極之出色嘅。從最基本嘅人物形象，到畫面嘅推進節奏，再到風情萬種嘅配樂，完全呈現出香港既平易近人又華貴富麗嘅多面景觀。我心目中最典型嘅香港電影所應該具備嘅特質，《文雀》包含咗八九成，總結起嚟就係港人對呢片土地所懷有嘅眷戀以及探索嘅渴望，再混合啲大都市特有嘅慾望同情感，成為咗一種富有生命力同動感嘅情愫。唔同于《花樣年華》一類影片所體現嘅舊時代嘅張愛玲式嘅從容慵懶憂鬱華麗，呢部電影既唔現代，又唔算得上久遠，佢令人覺得，香港就應該係咁嘅，香港嘅人亦應該就係咁嘅。對於好多冇去過香港嘅觀眾嚟講，亦都因為咁，就有咗所謂嘅“鄉愁”。

- Director Johnny To has chosen a very poetic English name for this movie—"A Love Letter to Hong Kong." From the name we can easily imagine that this is a movie full of romance and sentiment. People always ask why Hong Kong movies are so special and I say you can easily find the answer in this movie. The stories in the movie blend together quietly, or—at least—I can't find any remarkable conflicts or unexpected scenes in the film. However, just looking at its story telling, I don't have any complaints about the movie. Talking about its visual design, the movie is incredibly successful. From the basic design of its characters, to enhancing its visual effects, to choosing the right soundtrack for each scene, the film has done a tremendous job presenting both the luxurious and simple lifestyles in Hong Kong. In my opinion, we can easily find many of the most important characteristics of a typical Hong Kong movie in "A Love Letter to Hong Kong," including the nostalgia for our hometown, our curiosity, and desire for life. This movie is full of life and passion. It is different than movies like "In the Mood for Love," which represent the melancholy in Eileen Chang's style; this movie's style is not modern, nor ancient. It gives us an impression that this is how Hong Kong is supposed to be and how Hong Kong people are supposed to be like. For those who have not yet had a chance to get to know about Hong Kong, you might start having a feeling of "nostalgia" because of this movie.

In the course of shooting this film, Johnny To asked the choreographer of the Hong Kong Ballet to the set to help his actors hit their shots. The reason he did this was that he hoped to give his film the feeling of a musical. He said that it wasn't a pure musical, but that he wanted to give it a bit of a dance rhythm, and give the actors a sort of quiet and comic feeling. And so if you watch this movie and think that this film has a certain romantic feeling to it, why that is perfectly natural. This movie is—after all—*A Love Letter to Hong Kong*.
