我識講廣東話。	ngo5 sik1 gong2 gwong2 dung1 waa6.	I (know how to) speak Cantonese.
你識唔識講廣東話?	nei5 sik1 m4 sik1 gong2 gwong2 dung1 waa6?	Do you (know how to) speak Cantonese?
呢個點講?	ni1 go3 dim2 gong2?	How do you say this?
唔該細聲啲。	m4 goil sai3 seng1 dil.	Please lower your volume.
唔該講慢啲。	m4 goil gong2 maan6 dil .	Can you speak slowly please?
行慢啲。	haang4 maan6 dil.	Walk slower.
唔該慢啲講多次。	m4 goil maan6 dil gong2 dol ci3 .	Can you repeat again, slowly please?
行慢啲。	haang4 maan6 dil.	Walk slower.
唔該細聲啲。	m4 goil sai3 seng1 dil.	Please lower your volume.
唔該幫下我。	m4 goil bong1 haa5 ngo5.	Please help me.

"How do you say "_____ " in Cantonese?"

There are several names for Cantonese.

For Example:

1. 廣東話
gwong2 dung1 waa2
2. 白話
baak6 waa2
3. 粵語
jyut6 yu5

or more generally:

中文
zung1 man2

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"Chinese"

So instead of saying 廣東話點講 (gwong2 dung1 waa2 dim2 gong2) - "How do you say "___" in Cantonese," you can say, 中文點講 (zung1 man2 dim2 gong2) - "How do you say "___" in Chinese?"

Adjectives + 啲

唔該慢啲。 (m4 goi1 maan6 dil) - "Please slow down a bit."

Adding the term 啲 (dil) after an adjective, literally means "a little." We often use it when making a command; it softens the command somewhat.

For Example:

1. 慢
maan6
"slow"
2. 慢啲
maan6 dil
"a little slower"
3. 快啲
faai3 dil
"a little faster"
4. 大啲
daai6 dil
"a little bigger"
5. 細啲
sai3 dil
"a little smaller"

唔該幫我 + verb

唔該幫我寫低。 (m4 goi1 bong1 ngo5 se2 dail) - "Please write it down for me."

We commonly use this sentence structure in Chinese to ask a favor of someone. 幫 literally means "to help." To request someone's assistance or a favor, use this phrase as we heard in the dialogue: 唔該幫我寫低。 (m4 goi1 bong1 ngo5 se2 dail.) - "Please write it down for me." Literally, "Please help me write down."
