

Cultural Insight

Cantonese Superstitious Numbers

The Cantonese are quite superstitious about numbers, believing some to be auspicious, and others to be avoided as very unlucky. This originates from the fact that a lot of Cantonese words are homophones. Some numbers have pronunciations that are similar to other words with different meanings—words that have either good or bad connotations.

For example, the number four is believed to be very unlucky and avoided whenever possible. The reason is that the pronunciation of the number "four" (四, sei3) in Cantonese is very similar in sound to the word for "death" (死, sei2). The words are phonetically identical; they only differ in tone.

On the other hand, the word for "eight" (八, baat3) sounds very similar to the word for "prosper" or "wealth" (養, faat3), and therefore, is considered very lucky. Because of the supposed auspiciousness of certain numbers, some Cantonese people will even pay large sums of money for phone numbers, street addresses, vehicle license plate numbers, or bank account numbers that they feel are lucky.
