Olivia: 跑馬

Gabriella: horse racing

Olivia: (slow) 跑馬 (regular) 跑馬

Gabriella: Listeners, please repeat:

Gabriella: Established in 1884, the Royal Hong Kong Jockey Club conducts nearly 700 races every season at the two race tracks in Happy Valley and Sha Tin.

Gabriella: Now let's hear a sample sentence using this word.

Olivia: (normal) 我訂咗下個禮拜去賽馬會食飯,可以一邊食一邊睇跑馬。

Gabriella: I made a reservation for supper at the Jockey Club next week. We can watch the horse racing while we eat.

Olivia: (slow) 我訂咗下個禮拜去賽馬會食飯,可以一邊食一邊睇跑馬。

Gabriella: Okay, what's the next word?

Olivia: 足球

Gabriella: football (soccer)

Olivia: (slow) 足球 (regular) 足球

Gabriella: Listeners, please repeat:

Olivia: 足球

[pause - 5 sec.]

Gabriella: Football, also known as soccer in the U.S., is the most popular sport in Hong Kong. The Hong Kong Football Association (The HKFA), is the governing body of football in Hong Kong.

Gabriella: Now let's hear a sample sentence using this word.

Olivia: (normal) 落酒吧睇足球賽事好有氣氛。

Gabriella: If you watch soccer games at the bar, it is a great atmosphere.

Olivia: (slow) 落酒吧睇足球賽事好有氣氛。

Gabriella: Okay, what's the next word?

Olivia: 羽毛球

Gabriella: badminton

Olivia: (slow) 羽毛球 (regular) 羽毛球

Gabriella: Listeners, please repeat:

Olivia: 羽毛球

[pause - 5 sec.]

Gabriella: As a hugely popular sport in the urban confines of East Asia, badminton has a loyal following in Hong Kong. The Hong Kong Open Badminton Championship is one among the Badminton World Federation's line-up of Super Series events, with a big grand prize of US\$250,000.

Gabriella: Now let's hear a sample sentence using this word.

Olivia: (normal) 我先先仲以為羽毛球運動量小啲, 但原來都好攰架。

Gabriella: I thought badminton was just a small amount of exercise, but it turns out it's very tiring.

Olivia: (slow) 我先先仲以為羽毛球運動量小啲, 但原來都好攰架。

Gabriella: Okay, what's the next word?

Olivia: 保齡

Gabriella: bowling

Olivia: (slow) 保齡 (regular) 保齡

Gabriella: Listeners, please repeat:

Olivia: 保齡

[pause - 5 sec.]

Gabriella: There are several major bowling alleys scattered around Hong Kong, including the South China Athletic Association, the Yacht Club, and the Aberdeen Marina Club.

Gabriella: Now let's hear a sample sentence using this word.

Olivia: (normal) 姨丈每個星期三都約埋啲朋友去打保齡。

Gabriella: My uncle goes bowling with his friends every Wednesday.

Olivia: (slow) 姨丈每個星期三都約埋啲朋友去打保齡。

Gabriella: Okay, what's the last

word? Olivia: 乒乓波 Gabriella: table tennis Olivia: (slow) 乒乓波 (regular) 乒乓波 Gabriella: Listeners, please repeat: Olivia: 乒乓波 [pause - 5 sec.] Gabriella: Table tennis has been gaining in popularity since Hong Kong won its first silver medal for men's doubles in the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens. Gabriella: Now let's hear a sample sentence using this word. Olivia: (normal) 呢間房可以放一張乒乓波枱,做遊戲室。 Gabriella: We can put a table tennis table in this room and make it into a game room. Olivia: (slow) 呢間房可以放一張乒乓波枱,做遊戲室。
