## **CULTURAL INSIGHT**

#### 1. The Peak

Victoria Peak, often referred to simply as the Peak, is a mountain in the western half of Hong Kong Island. It's a major tourist attraction that offers views over the surrounding areas.

#### 2. Victoria Harbor

Victoria Harbor is described as "the million-dollar night view." Every night it presents Symphony of Lights, a synchronised outside decorative light and laser multimedia display featuring 44 buildings on both sides of the harbor.

#### 3. Avenue of Stars

The Avenue of Stars is modelled on Hollywood's Walk of Fame. It's located along the Victoria Harbor waterfront in Tsim Sha Tsui.

### 4. Ocean Park

Ocean Park is a marine mammal park, aquarium, animal theme park, and amusement park which opened in 1977. The park has been named the world's Seventh Most Popular Amusement Park and is one of the "50 Most Visited Tourist Attractions," according to Forbes.

## 5. Tian Tan Buddha

The Buddha is 34 meters tall, weighs 250 metric tons, and was the world's tallest outdoor bronze seated Buddha until 2007.
