CULTURAL INSIGHT

1. Egg roll

An egg roll is a type of flaky biscuit made with egg, flour, and sugar.

2. Haw flakes

Haw flakes are Chinese sweets made from hawthorn fruit. Some Chinese take the flakes with bitter Chinese herbal medicine.

3. Shrimp noodle

One of the special characteristics that distinguishes shrimp noodles from the many other kinds of Chinese noodles is the salty shrimp roe that forms tiny black spots on strips of the noodles.

4. Almond cookies

An almond cookie is a type of small, unfilled Chinese pastry. They tend to be very crunchy and sometimes crumble when the first bite is taken.

5. Sachima

A sachima is similar to a Rice Krispy treat but slightly sweeter. Its texture ranges from chewy to crunchy, depending on the variety.
