VOCABULARY

Traditional	Romanization	English	Class
學生	hok6 sang1	student	noun
教師	gaau3 si1	teacher	noun
邊度	bin1 dou6	where	pronoun
係	hai6	to be	verb
律師	leot6 si1	lawyer	noun

SAMPLE SENTENCES

我係學生。 <i>ngo5 hai6 hok6 sang1。</i> I'm a student.	英文教師 English teacher
去咗邊度?	我係學生。
<i>heoi3 zo2 bin1 dou6?</i>	<i>Ngo5 hai6 hok6 saang1。</i>
Where did (you) go?	"I am a student."

你係唔係律師? nei5 hai6 m4 hai6 leot6 si1?

Are you a lawyer?

GRAMMAR

The focus of this lesson is talking about your nationality in Cantonese

Topic 1: How to Ask and Talk about Nationalities

Sentence from the lesson:

'你係邊度嚟咖?' *nei5 hai6 bin1 dou6 lei4 gaa3?* "Where do you come from?"

- 你 nei5 "you"
 係 hai6 is "to be";
 邊度 bin1 dou6 means "where?"
 嚟 lei4 is "to come"
 咖 gaa3 is a question particle.
- Answering this question is very easy! You just say 我係 ngo5 hai6, which means "I am," then your nationality.
 For example:
- Just replace 美國 *mei5 gwok3* with your own nationality.
 "I am German" is 我係德國人 ngo5 hai6 dak1 gwok3 jan
- 4. To return the question you can simply say 你呢 *nei5 le1* which is "And you?."

Topic 2: How to say who you are

Other than nationality, you can also talk about your occupation by just replacing $\notin \boxtimes \land$ mei gwok3 jan4 "American," with the occupation.

For example:

我係律師 ngo5 hai6 leot3 si1 "I am a lawyer"

我係學生 ngo5 hai6 hok6 saang1 "I am a student"

我係教師 ngo5 hai6 gaau3 si1 "I am a teacher"

Language Tip!

Pay attention that in Cantonese, we don't use *hai6*in front of verbs, only nouns.

For example:

It would be wrong to say 我係讀緊書 *ngo5 hai6 duk6 gan2 syu1* when you want to express "I am studying." It should be just 我讀緊書 *ngo5 duk6 gan2 syu1*, literally "I studying."
