GRAMMAR

The focus of this lesson is talking about location in Cantonese

Topic 1: How to ask about others' location

Sentence from the lesson:

你喺邊?

nei5 hai2 bin1?

"Where are you?"

- Let's break this sentence down.
 - 你 nei5 is "You"
 - 喺 hai2 means "are"
 - 邊 bin1 is "where?"
- 2. Answering this question is very easy! You just say *ngo5 hai2* + the place where you are.
 - 我 *ngo5* means "I" and
 - 喺 hai2 is that verb "to be" again.

Then you add the place.

So for example, you can say 我喺街 ngo5 hai2 gaai1 which is "I am on the street"

- 3. Now let's look at some other possible answers:
 - "I am in the office" would be 我喺公司 $\mathit{ngo5}$ hai2 $\mathit{gung1}$ si
 - "I am at the subway station" would be 我喺地鐵站 ngo5 hai2 dei6 tit3 zaam6.
 - "I am home" would be 我喺屋企 ngo5 hai2 uk1 kei
- 4. This verb can be used for inanimate objects as well, as long as it is about the location.

學校喺右邊 hok6 haau3 hai2 jau3 bin1 "school is on the right side" 支筆喺地下 zi1 bat1 hai2 dei6 haa5 "the pen is on the floor"

Language Tip!

Also with the verb 喺 hai2, you can use this convenient question if you are lost in the street: 我 蕩失路,請問我 喺邊? ngo5 dong6 sat1 lou6, cing2 man6 ngo5 hai2 bin1?
That means "I'm lost, can you tell me where I am?"
