The focus of this lesson is how to say "Thank You" in Cantonese

Topic 1: How to Thank someone

Sentence from the lesson:

'唔該'

M4 goi1

"Thank you"

- 1. 唔該 (M4 goi1). means "Thank you."
- When saying "thank you very much" you just need to add 晒 (saai3).
- 题 (saai3) means "entirely." So 唔該晒 (M4 goi1 saai3) is like saying "Thank you very much."
- 4. Another way to thank someone in Cantonese is 多謝 (Do1 ze6). It is used when you have received a gift or money.

For Example:

多謝

Do1 ze6

"Thank you (informal)"

Topic 2: How to Say "You're welcome"

Sentence from the lesson:

'唔駛客氣'

M4 sai2 haak3 hei3

"no need to be polite"

1. 唔駛客氣(M4 sai2 haak3 hei3). Literally means "no need to be polite," but it is the equivalent of "you are welcome."

Language Tip!

If you're not sure about whether to use 唔該 (*M4 goi1*) or 多謝 (*Do1 ze6*), remember that 多謝 (*Do1 ze6*) expresses a deeper appreciation of personal kindness, and is used in most formal situations.
