## **CULTURAL INSIGHT**

#### **Quick Tip**

Hong Kong employs a state-of-the-art mass rapid transit system popularly referred to as the MTR. In use since 1979, over four thousand trips are made every weekday. The system covers more than 211 kilometers, reaching almost every corner of Hong Kong. The MTR operates on a "zone" fare system, so depending on where you go, your ticket fare will change in price. For adults, fares can range from 3 HKD to 47HKD.
