CULTURAL INSIGHT

Quick Tip

Asking someone to write something down for you can be very helpful...if it is in your own language! Remember that the *Jyutping* (the romanization of Cantonese Characters) alphabet is different from the English, so unless you study the *Jyutping* letters, you should ask how to write it down in English. 唔該寫低個英文。(m4 goi1 se2 dai1 go3 jing1 man2.) - "Please write down the English for me."
