CULTURAL INSIGHT

Quick Tip

Buying stamps in the Cantonese world is very simple. They sell normal stamps at 郵局 (jau4

guk4), so saying 我要郵票 (ngo5 jiu3 jau4 piu3) - "I would like some stamps" is the simplest and most common way of asking for them. Remembering your numbers comes in handy here, as they will most likely ask you how many you want.
