TRADITIONAL CHINESE

3. 今集我們會介紹香港的聖誕節。
4. 相信大家都很熟悉，聖誕節就是在12月25日。現在就來看看香港人是如何慶祝聖誕節吧！

ENGLISH

1. Hello, everybody, I'm Olivia.
2. Welcome to the Hong Kong Holiday Series.
3. In this lesson, we will talk about Christmas in Hong Kong.
4. I think everyone is familiar with Christmas, and know that it's on December 25. But let's see how Hong Kong people celebrate Christmas!
5. Can you guess how much a Christmas dinner costs at a hotel in Hong Kong? We'll show you the answer at the end of this video.

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6. Hong Kong has a nice Christmas atmosphere, with everybody busy getting ready for all kinds of parties. Of course, at the parties, gifts will be exchanged, so everyone has to go shopping beforehand. Since all the shops have sales during this time, everyone's shopping desires can definitely be satisfied.
7. Let me tell you which are Hong Kong's most popular and beautifully decorated places around Christmas—Harbour City, 1881 Heritage, and the Peninsula Hotel in Tsim Sha Tsui; Times Square in Causeway Bay; the Statue Square in Central; and Disneyland on Lantau Island. Many buildings and skyscrapers next to Victoria Harbour put up Christmas light displays, so both locals and tourists like to ride the Star Ferry and see the marvelous night-time scenery on both sides of the harbor.
8. The biggest difference between Christmas in Hong Kong and Western countries is probably the Christmas dinner. Rather than enjoying it at home, most people in Hong Kong eat at restaurants and hotels, or arrange catering. All the restaurants and hotels promote set menus or buffet service with Christmas themes. It's very difficult to get a booking if you don't make it weeks in advance.
9. It never snows in Hong Kong, so some shopping malls will make fake snow, fake snowmen, and icy displays to attract customers. Also, because of the hot weather, there are no outdoor ice-skating rinks in Hong Kong, but there are several indoor ice rinks.

12. The average cost for Christmas dinner at a hotel in Hong Kong is HK\$50 per person, which is roughly US\$5. Compared to your country, is that expensive or cheap?
