TRADITIONAL CHINESE

- 大家好,我是Olivia。
- 2. 歡迎收看「香港節日系列」。
- 今集我們會介紹中國的國慶。
- 4. 1949年10月1日新中國成立,所以以後每年的10月1日都是國慶日。
- 5. 國慶日假期在中國是個喜慶的節日;但在香港,卻令人聯想到一個悲劇。
- 6. 國慶節期間,香港的商場及名店總是會比平日更加人山人海,你知道是為什麼嗎?
- 7. 我會在這影片最後公佈答案。
- 8. 在中國大陸, 國慶日是一個非常重大的節日, 稱之為「十一黄金週」。
- 9. 七天的假期內到處舉行慶祝,除了去天安門看升旗和閱兵等各種儀式,很 多人都會趁這個時候回鄉探親或出外旅行,導致嚴重塞車,車票難求。
- 10. 但另一邊廂, 跟據統計, 對於香港人來說, 國慶日只不過是一天的假期, 沒有什麼值得慶祝的。
- 11. 唯一吸引港人的是在維多利亞港舉行的國慶煙花匯演,每年都吸引海港兩岸大量市民觀賞。
- 12. 但在2012年,一艘客船載著127人前往中環對開海面欣賞煙花時,被另一雙體船攔腰撞擊後迅速翻沉,事件做成39人死亡,101人受傷,令本來的慶祝活動頓變愁雲慘霧,這是香港史上最嚴重的海上事故以及遇難人數最多的災難事故之一。

- 13. 香港賽馬會每年也舉行國慶賽馬日。
- 14. 當日除了賽馬外,還有著名中國歌唱家及傳統技藝表演者,於馬場內舉行 各式文藝及民俗表演,與馬迷一同歡度一個充滿民族特色的國慶日。
- 15. 現在就來揭曉問題的答案。
- 16. 國慶節期間,香港的商場及名店總是會比平日更加人山人海,你知道是為什麼嗎?
- 17. 這是因為國慶黄金週令大量大陸遊客湧至香港購物,所以雖然香港的國慶節假期只有一天,但整個禮拜都人頭湧湧,尤其是名店和商場。

ENGLISH

- 1. Hello, everybody, I'm Olivia.
- Welcome to the Hong Kong Holiday Series.
- In this lesson, we will talk about China's National Day.
- 4. The People's Republic of China was founded in October 1949, so National Day falls every October 1.

- 5. The National Day holiday generally lasts seven days in mainland China, and is a very big event there, but in Hong Kong, it is reminiscent of a tragedy.
- 6. During National Day, the malls and brand name stores in Hong Kong are more crowded than usual. Do you know why?
- 7. We'll show you the answer at the end of this video.
- 8. National Day is a very important festival in mainland China, known as October 1st Golden Week.
- 9. All kinds of celebration are held throughout the seven-day holiday. As well as watching the flag-raising and marching ceremony at Tiananmen Square, a lot of people take this opportunity to return home to visit relatives or travel aboard, resulting in serious traffic jams and sold out tickets.
- 10. On the other hand, according to the statistics, for Hong Kong people, National Day is merely a day of holiday, and there is nothing worth celebrating.
- The only thing that can cheer up Hong Kong people is the National Day fireworks display in Victoria Harbour; every year it attracts many spectators on both sides of the harbor.
- 12. But in 2012, while a passenger ship carrying 127 people was heading to Central to see the fireworks, it was hit by a catamaran and soon capsized. Thirty-nine people were killed and 101 people were injured in this incident, meaning this day of celebration turned into one of grief throughout Hong Kong. It is one of the most serious accidents at sea, and had the greatest number of victims in Hong Kong history.
- 13. Every year, The Hong Kong Jockey Club holds the National Day Race Day.

- 14. Other than horse racing, there are also performances by famous Chinese singers and traditional arts performers, so racing fans can celebrate the National Day filled with national characteristics.
- 15. And now I'll give you the answer to the earlier quiz.
- 16. During National Day, the malls and brand name stores in Hong Kong are more crowded than usual. Do you know why?
- 17. During the National Day Golden Week, a large number of mainland tourists come to Hong Kong for shopping. So although the Hong Kong National Day holiday is only one day long, it is crowded everywhere throughout the week, especially the brand name stores and malls.
- 18. How was this lesson? Did you learn a lot of interesting things?
