

## Tips for success in this class:

- 1. Download your free 70 page course workbook at: <u>https://tinyurl.com/y8sd8nbg</u>
- 2. Print the workbook before starting the course. When watching the video lessons, have your workbook open to the current lesson. Many lessons have activities and quizzes you need to complete during the video. You will find them in the workbook. There is also a section to take notes on each video in your workbook. You will find answers to the assignments in the back of the workbook. Make sure to check your answers after completing the assignment to make sure you are understanding the material. If anything is unclear, please ask for clarification in the comments section of the lesson or during weekly office hours.
- 3. Do the course in order. Do not skip around to different sections. You need to start with part 1, and then do part 2, etc. Newer lessons build on concepts learned in earlier sections.
- 4. Record yourself doing the course pretest before beginning the course. Audio or video is fine. Make sure to save this file where you can easily find it again. You will want to compare your recording before the course and then again at the end of the course to hear your improvement.
- 5. For best study results, give your practice 100% of your attention.
  - a. Find a quiet place where you will not be disturbed and where you are able to speak out loud without disturbing others or feeling self conscious or embarrassed.
  - b. Turn off your cell phone and other electronic devices if you are not using them to study. Mute email or other apps with pop up and sound notifications on your phone/computer.
  - c. You don't need to spend excessive amounts of time practicing. You just need to make sure your practice is focused and efficient. Don't multitask!
- 6. Go at your own pace, as fast or slow as you like. Just make sure to do the assignments before watching more video lessons.
- Your accent will not improve itself. <u>You must practice, not just watch the videos, but</u> <u>really do the work.</u> Like learning to play guitar or swim, you must do the work to see the results.
