

ADJECTIVES IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Adjectives describe nouns. They have the same form in the singular and plural.

Adjectives go before nouns or after the verb **to be** or after verbs such as

look, smell, sound, feel, taste, etc

ORDER OF ADJECTIVES



We do not usually have a long list of adjectives before a single noun. One noun is usually described by one, two or three adjectives at the most.

ADJECTIVES ENDING IN -ED AND -ING

We use adjectives that end with **-ED**
to describe people's feeling

We use adjectives that end with **-ING**
to talk about a thing or person that
makes us have that feeling
