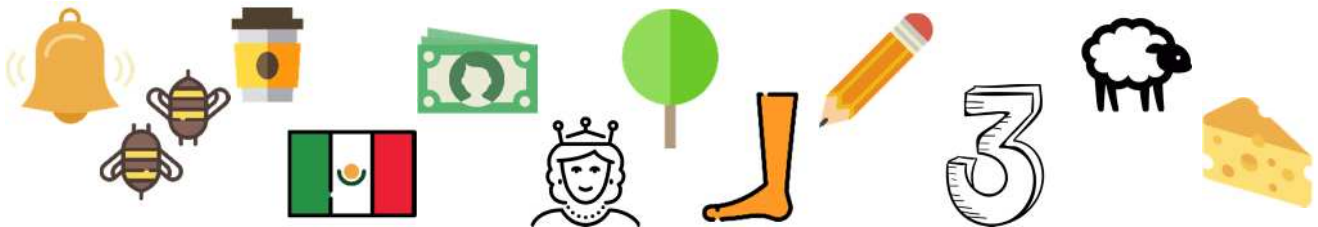


Exercises for /i:/ and /e/
